How to get to IIASA:



IIASA is located in Laxenburg, Am Schlossplatz 1
(<https://maps.app.goo.gl/AcR74cz7WiY8WQhK>)

The Symposium will take place in the Main Building, Gvishiani Room, 1st floor, right from main entrance

You will need to leave the EGU at around 15:50 to make it in time.

By Bus: Enter the Regional *Bus 210* Main Station at **16:20**. Exit the Bus at 16:52 after a 34 min. ride and 14 stops at Laxenburg Franz – Joseph-Pl. You are right in the center of Laxenburg, IIASA is a 5 min. walk away.

By Train: Enter the U1 at U Kaisermuehlen at 16:00 pm latest to arrive at Vienna Mainstation/Suedtiroler platz at around 16:16. Enter the the regional train *R95 Traiskirchen-Aspangbahn* at Vienna Main Station at **16:27** (usually departing from tracks 9-11). Exit at train Station Laxenburg-Biedermannsdorf at **16:47**. From the train station turn left and follow the road untel reaching Wiener Strasse. Turn left and follow Wiener str. for about 15 min. IIASA is located in the Laxenburg Palace at the end of the road. Please reach out to us in case a shuttle from Laxenburg station to IIASA is needed.
